

10-2-2020 COVID Update from Superintendent

Warren County Department of Health has been working with the district and completed a comprehensive investigation. They have identified the students that were in proximate contact with the COVID positive individual. They have contacted all families involved.

Out of an abundance of caution, Warren County Department of Health has placed those students on **mandatory quarantine**. Those students **will not be able to return** to in-person learning until Tuesday, 10-13-2020.

The location in our building that is connected to the COVID positive individual has been thoroughly cleaned and disinfected in accordance with guidance from NYS and CDC.

As always, please continue to monitor all of your children for any symptoms of COVID. Please contact your health care provider or Warren County Health Department for guidance should your child(ren) have any of the following symptoms.

- Cough
- Fever
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

North Warren will be open on Monday, October 5th for in-person learning for all other students.
