Childcare for Essential Workers and First Responders

Dear North Warren Families,

Governor Cuomo recently informed school districts to establish and submit plans for the care of children of essential Health Care Workers and First Responders. Essential health care workers may include licensed health professionals such as physicians, nurse practitioners, physician assistants, registered nurses, LPNs and nurse assistants or laboratory personnel. First responders may include paramedics, emergency medical technicians, police officers, and firefighters.

We are working together with our area licensed childcare providers, the WSWHE BOCES and our neighboring schools, to determine regional capacity and identify local/regional need.

We will work with families in need to find available placements in our region and existing licensed daycare providers where there are openings. Depending on need, our BOCES may be establishing an approved childcare center. We are not yet sure where this program may be located.


