This is a reminder that our school will be closed for classes until April 19th in an effort to minimize the spread of COVID-19 virus.

Information for families as of March 16, 2020:

Building will be open as follows:

Tomorrow March 17th 11:00 AM to 5:00 PM

During the above time, all students should retrieve all items, including items in gym lockers. This will allow for adequate cleaning of all locker and cubby areas. To practice social distancing, only 1 parent/guardian will be allowed in the building with a student.

Students are requested to come to the building **only one time** on Tuesday this week. The Department of Health is recommending students stay home and not go into public spaces unnecessarily.

Please Note: All chromebooks have been thoroughly disinfected prior to your picking them up.

Grades PreK – 2 - No chromebooks will be provided at this time. Students will pick up a bag of materials with school work.

Grades 3 – 6 - Pick up bag of materials and chromebook for additional online instruction, pick up band instruments.

Grades 7 – 12 – Pick up chromebooks for online materials and band instruments.
