

Message from the Superintendent November 11,2020

Early this afternoon the district learned that an individual at North Warren Central School District tested positive for COVID-19. The individual is based in our elementary wing.

We have contacted all families involved. A third grade classroom, their teacher, and an additional staff member have all been quarantined.

Since the beginning of the school year, the North Warren Central School District has been following all of the proper protocols including daily health screenings, physical distancing, mask wearing, and handwashing. The district has also been thoroughly cleaning and disinfecting our building daily in accordance with guidance from the New York State Department of Health and the CDC.

As a continued added measure of precaution, please monitor your child(ren) for any symptoms of COVID. Please note the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) and other privacy laws prohibit us from disclosing or confirming any personally identifiable information. We cannot identify anyone who has tested positive.
