Per Governor's executive order, effective November 4th the new travel guidelines are as follows:

As a general rule, all travelers entering New York from a state that is not a contiguous state must quarantine for a period of 14 days in accordance with quarantine rules prescribed by the Department of Health (DOH) unless they comply with the following "test-out" rules which would permit a shortened quarantine period as follows.

- Travelers who were in another state for less than 24 hours are not required to quarantine upon their arrival in New York but must now complete a State travel information form and take a COVID diagnostic test four (4) days after their arrival.
- Travelers who were in another state for more than 24 hours must obtain a COVID test within the 72 hours preceding their departure from that state, must quarantine for at least three (3) days following their arrival in New York, and must then obtain a second COVID test no earlier than day four (4) of their quarantine. If both COVID tests are negative, the traveler may exit quarantine upon receipt of the second negative test result.

In the event a traveler does not submit to the early release from quarantine testing protocols, he or she would remain subject to the general 14-day mandatory quarantine rule.
