10-9-2020 COVID Update from Superintendent

Warren County Department of Health has been working with the district and completed a comprehensive investigation. They have identified the students who were in proximate contact with the COVID positive individual. DOH has contacted all families involved.

Out of an abundance of caution, Warren County Department of Health has placed those students on **mandatory quarantine**. Those students **will not be able to return** to in-person learning until Thursday 10-22-2020.

The locations in our building that are connected to the COVID positive individual have been thoroughly cleaned and disinfected in accordance with guidance from NYS and CDC.

Please, I am **pleading with each of you** to continue to monitor all of your children for any symptoms of COVID. Please contact your health care provider or Warren County Health Department for guidance should your child(ren) have any of the following symptoms and **KEEP THEM HOME!**

- Cough
- Fever
- · Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatique
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

Please note the following change:

North Warren will be open for all students **PK-6** for in-person learning on Tuesday, October 13th and going forward.

North Warren will NOT be open for students in grades 7-12th for in-person learning from October 13 through October 21st. All 7-12th grade students are now on a remote schedule. All 7-12th grade students cannot report for in-person learning until October 22nd.
