Summer School Information

Warning letters for students who are at risk of not passing core courses required for graduation will include information about the summer school program. These letters will be sent home shortly. Options for summer school programs include the Regional Summer School hosted at Queensbury Union Free School District. For students in grades 7 or 8, the Queensbury Summer Academy will run from 8:00 to noon:

- Starts on Tuesday, July 5th, and will meet Monday-Thursday each week
 - Courses end on Tuesday, August 15th.
 - Cost for North Warren Students will be \$200.
 - Registration will take place at North Warren
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- For Students in Grades 9-12, the Summer School program will also start on Wednesday, July 5th, and the dates will be the same as above, with Regents Examinations being administered on August 16th & 17th.
 - Registration will take place at North Warren.
 - Transportation will be the responsibility of the parent / student. Please contact Mr. Therio if you have any questions. Cost of each class will be \$100.00.
 - **For those who would like to take online or correspondence alternatives, the courses will cost \$116.00 per class, must begin the week of July 3rd, and be fully completed by Tuesday, August 15th. Coursework submitted after this date cannot be accepted for credit. There will also be a mid-summer check-in required for any online or correspondence courses that will take place at North Warren during the last week of July.**
