Dear North Warren Families,

North Warren has used up all of its allotted snow days for this school year. In the event we are advised to close due to weather related conditions, North Warren will hold classes for students virtually. **No** out of district transportation or classes will be provided if we switch to virtual learning.

If there is a prediction of weather, teachers will make sure all PK-12 students go home with their chrome books and chargers.

Our goal is NOT to have to close, but if a 2 or 3 hour delay can't be used then we will go to our modified virtual day.

As always, I will do my morning robo call and will be very specific as to what we are going to do for the day— delay or go remote. Please listen carefully to my calls and instructions.

All students will be required to log in (invites by teachers will be sent) by 10 am for a virtual closure.

PK-6 will follow the provided schedule given at 10 by their classroom teacher and instruction will end at 11:45 am.

7-12 will log in at 10 am for HB and then go period by period so that they interact with all classroom/subject teachers and will be able to log off by 11:45. The virtual period schedule will be posted on the website for students to reference.

All levels will then be asynchronous for the remainder of our virtual day to complete assignments posted in their classrooms or provided during session with their teacher.

Hopefully, we won't need this option and delays will get us through February and March and (sometimes April) in the Adirondacks.
